Dear *Dendrobium speciosum* Friends,

Here is a list of the select divisions currently for sale in the main sales area that were not previously on our earlier "Exceptional Divisions List". By now all have finished blooming, but below we have pictures from them in full bloom. Current prices range from \$100-\$1500. As the plants send out their new growths this summer, we will update photos as we can and might increase the prices.

Please note/be warned that *speciosum* color varies on the same plant as the buds open and the flowers age!! Really- a lot! Maybe also from year to year, possibly depending on light and temperature. Also the flower color in person varies from our pictures. Flower color was estimated using the terms: white, cream, butter yellow, light yellow (approx copy paper yellow), medium yellow, and dark yellow. Very few 100% *speciosum* are dark yellow. Flower size also varies on the same plant, possibly by the number of spikes and the plant size. For some plants we hurriedly measured floral dimensions on each plant, but they vary a lot even on a single plant. NS=natural spread, NH=natural height, PL=petal length, FP=made up term for the length of the stem that has flowers on it (the Flowering Part of the stem).

First come, first served. To reserve a plant, payment of plant price is required. It is best to e-mail your plant request (to show the time and date) providing the plant name, CBO number, and G number. sboe@sborchid.com Then please call with your credit card if you don't have one on file [(805) 967 1284]. We will update the list as often as we can.

These pictures were taken between early March through early April 2025.

When seen in person, some plants are more beautiful than their pictures, others are less beautiful than their pictures.

Sometimes we tried to show a scale in the background. Sometimes the black board has foot markings on it, sometimes not. The black board is approximately 39 inches wide and 30 inches high.

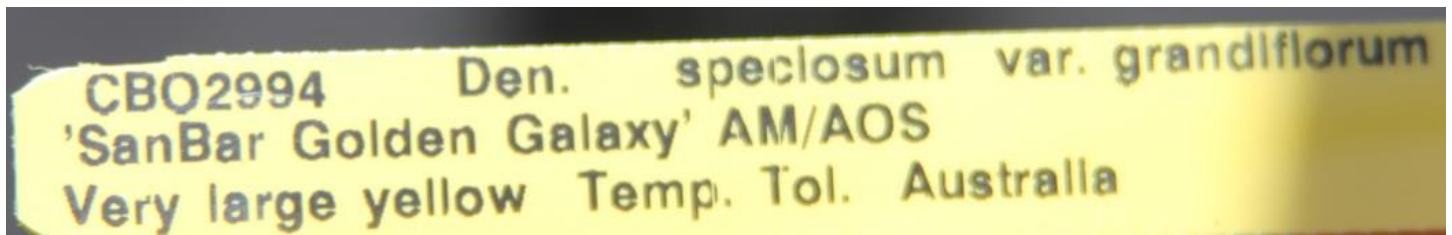

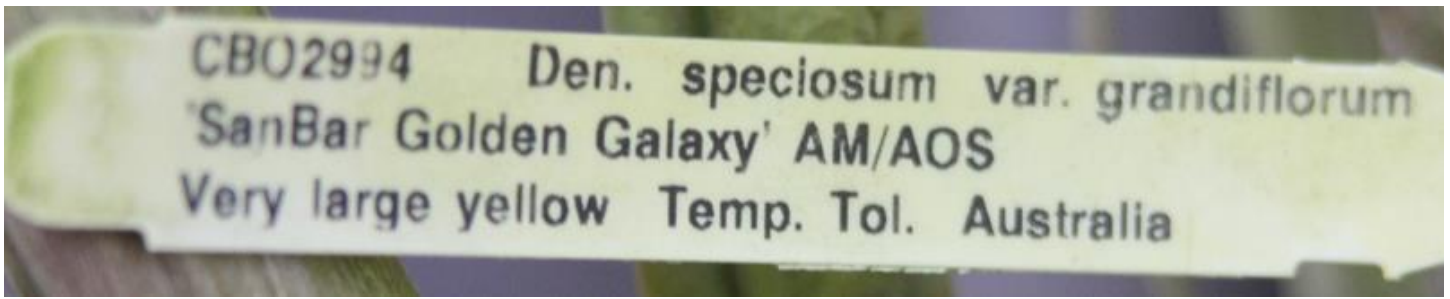

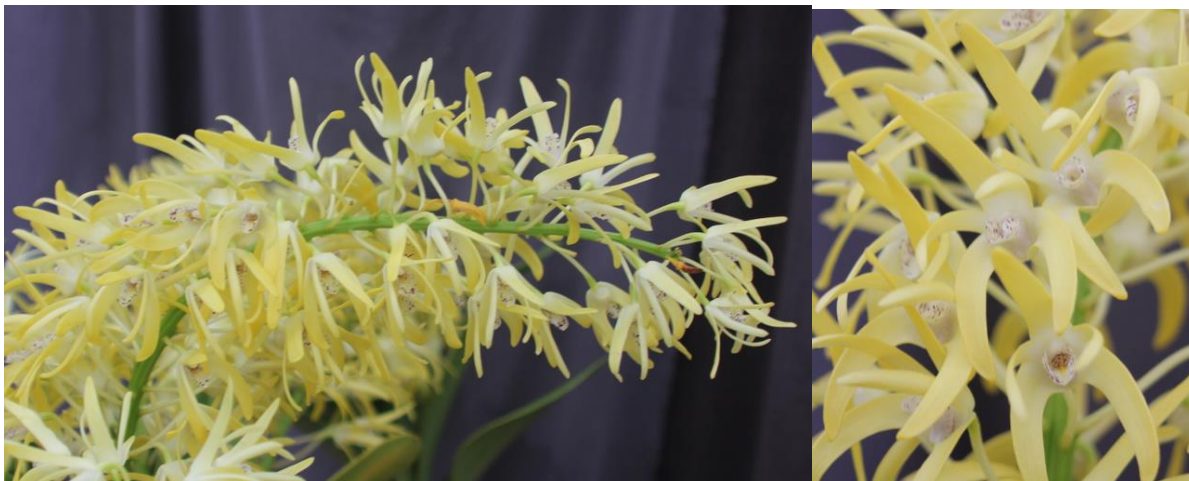


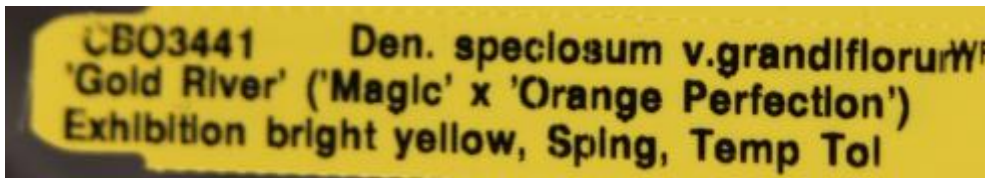
G100, \$500. 6" pot set in an 8" pot, NS=5cm, NH=8cm, PL=5cm, FP=43cm, Dark yellow. Note: these measurements differ from plant just below. Flower size does seem to vary by the size of the plant and the number of spikes. Based on the bigger plant offered below, this cultivar's flowers lasted a month this Spring (which was generally cool). From the var. grandiflora cross 'Magic' x 'Orange Perfection' bought in a flask from Tinonee of Australia.



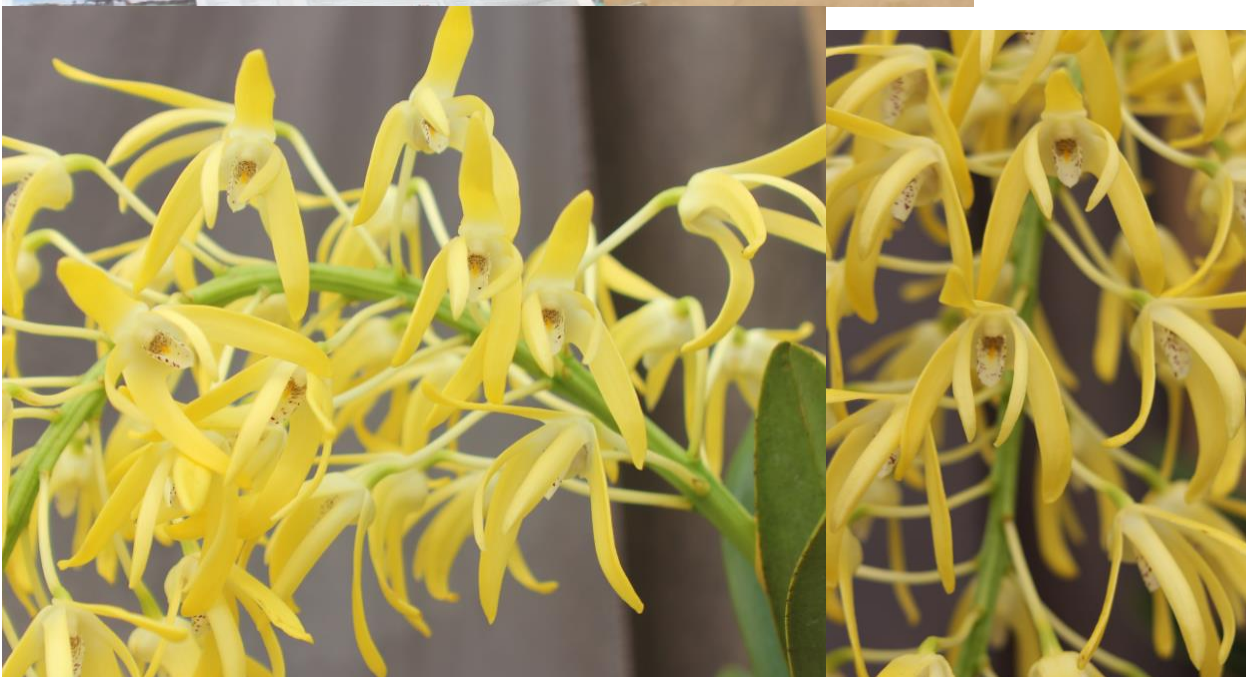


G23 650\$. 8" pot, 9 spikes, NS=2cm, NH=5cm, PL=3.5cm, FP=23-35cm, Medium yellow. From the var. grandiflora cross 'Magic' x 'Orange Perfection' bought in a flask from Tinonee of Australia. Flowers seem to be longer lasting, picture from just after show (3/12/225, after they were already open a week), but on 4/7/25 they are just beginning to get old. It has been a relatively cool here, so it may not last as long for you.





G44 \$900, 1 spike, 6" pot set in an 8" pot, Measurements from mid March 2025 :NS=3.1cm, NH=5.0cm, PL=3.6cm, FP=36cm. Medium yellow. Measurements from early April 2025: NS=4.75cm, NH=8cm, PL=4.5cm, FP=45cm?, Dark Yellow. One of our best grandiflorums. Flask from Tinonee of Australia.

G93, \$1500, 8" pot set in a 10" pot, 2 spikes, NS=3,5cm, NH=7.5cm, PL=5cm, FP=63cm. Medium yellow. One of our best grandiflora. This plant G93 has made a whopper tall bulb. Flask from Tinonee of Australia.



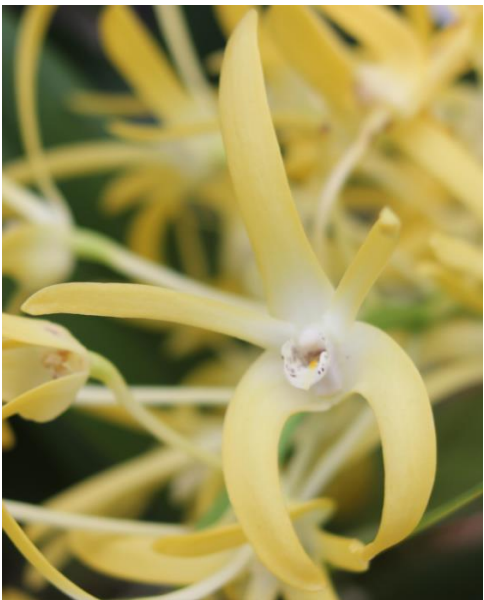


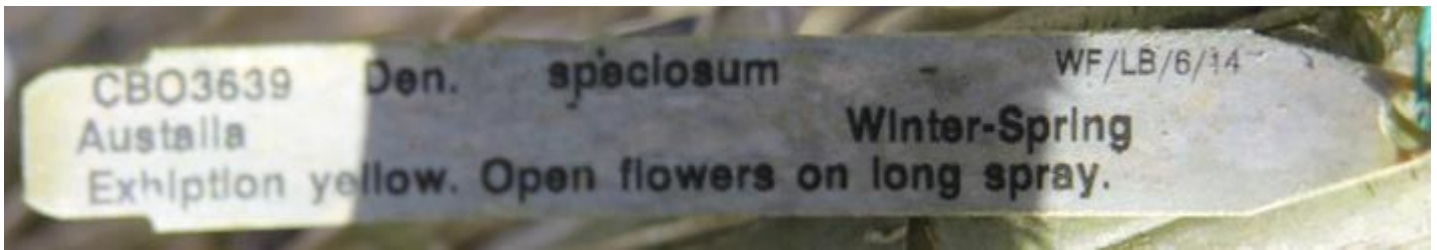
G90 \$350, 6" pot set in an 8" pot, 3 spikes, NS=5.25cm, NH=8cm, PL=5cm, FP=19-42cm, Medium yellow. Flask from Tinonee of Australia.





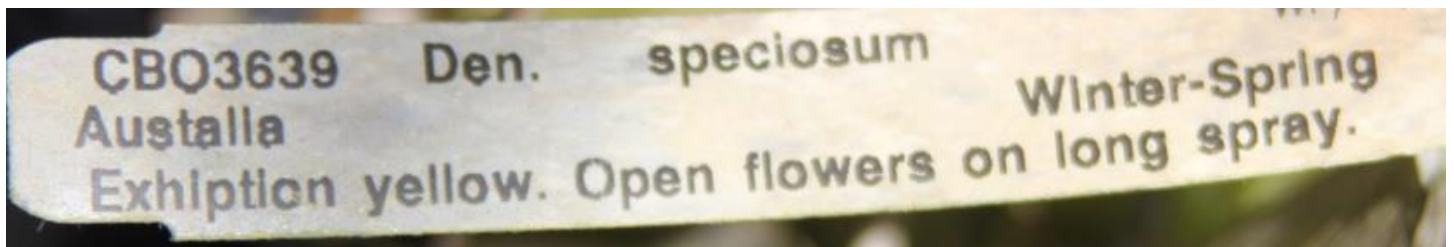
G04, \$500, 2 spikes, 8" pot, NS=6.3cm, NH=7.8cm, PL=4.1cm, FP=26-29cm. Medium yellow flowers. Huge flowers and beautiful foliage make this one a useful breeder. Flask from Tinonee of Australia.





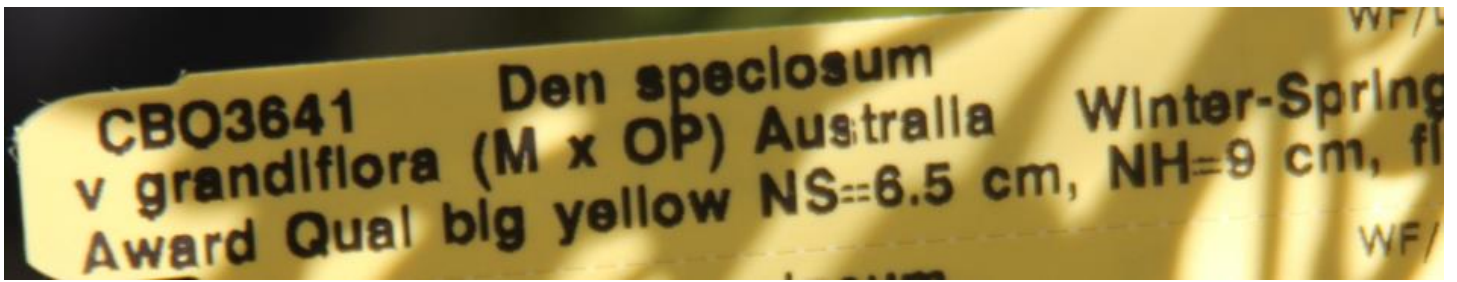
G86, \$175. 6" pot set in an 8" pot, 1 spike, NS=3.5cm, NH=5.5cm, PL=3.5cm, FP=35cm. Light yellow. Graceful arching spike habit, Open flowers. Bigger plants have longer spikes. Flask from Brian Gerhard of the cross v. speciosum 'Neville' x v. curvicaule 'Daylight Moon'.





G87. \$100, 6" pot set in an 8" pot, 1 spike, NS=2cm, NH=4.5cm, PL=2.8cm, FP=39cm. Light yellow. Graceful arching spike habit, Open flowers. Bigger plants have longer spikes. Flask from Brian Gerhard of the cross v. speciosum 'Neville' x v. curvicaule 'Daylight Moon'.





G83, \$400, 6" pot set in an 8" pot, 4 spikes, NS=4cm, NH=7cm, PL=5.5cm, FP=29-44cm. Medium yellow. In an earlier year, flowers were much bigger, ugh. From the var. grandiflora cross 'Magic' x 'Orange Perfection' bought in a flask from Tinonee of Australia.



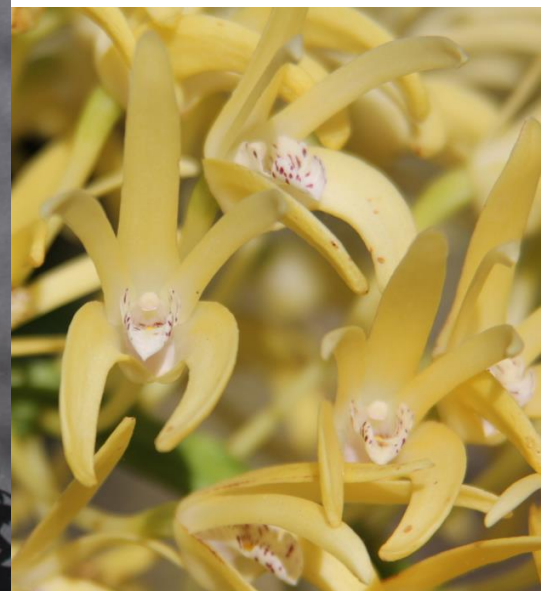


G79 \$250, 6" pot set in an 8" pot. 2 spikes, NS=6.25cm, NH=7cm, PL=4.5cm, FP=35-36cm, Butter yellow. From the var. grandiflora cross 'Magic' x 'Orange Perfection' bought in a flask from Tinonee of Australia.





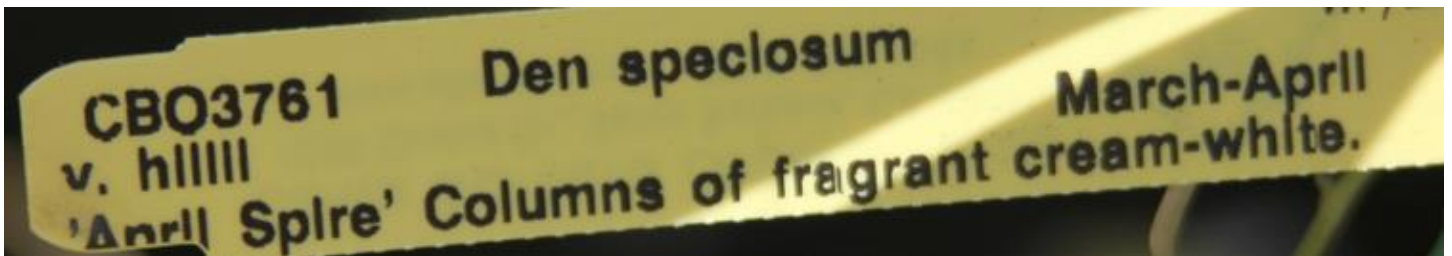
G120, \$400, 8" pot set in a 12" pot, 2 spikes, NS=2.5cm, NH=5cm, PL=3.75cm, FP=43-55cm. Medium yellow. Just a beautiful looking plant all around with very tall bulbs. Flask from Brian Gerhard of Australia.





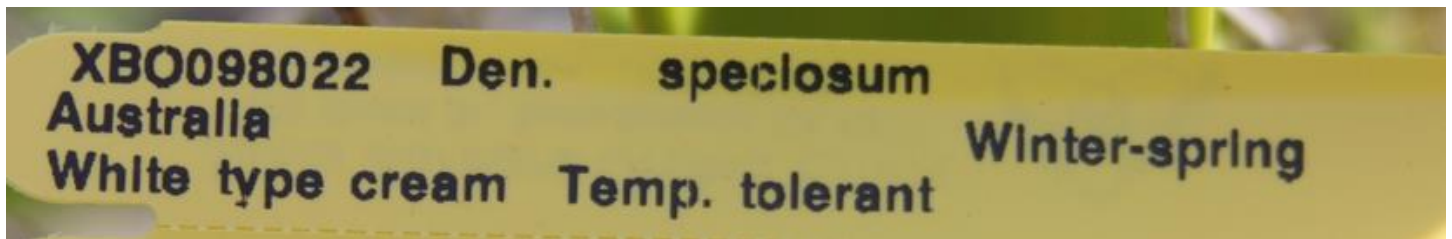
G71 \$150. 8" pot. 6 spikes, NS=2cm, NH=3cm, PL=2cm, FP=29-33. Cream. From the H&R cross of 'Zelda' x var. grandiflorum, although we see little influence from grandiflorum.





G64, \$500.8" pot, 4 spikes, NS=4cm, NH=4.75cm, PL=3,5cm, FP=38-45cm. Cream. From our cross hillii select variety x hillii 'Don Brown' Just a beautiful plant that could be a picture postcard for Dendrobium speciosum.





G50. \$100, 3 spikes, 6" pot set in an 8" pot. 3 spikes, NS=2.25cm, NH=3.75cm, PL=3.5cm, FL=26-42cm. Cream. From the cross of hillii select variety x hillii 'Don Brown', so this is a straight hillii. Plant tag has been updated since this picture was taken on 4/1/25.
